My grandmother, Maria, was born on March 10th, 1938.

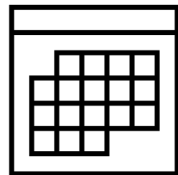

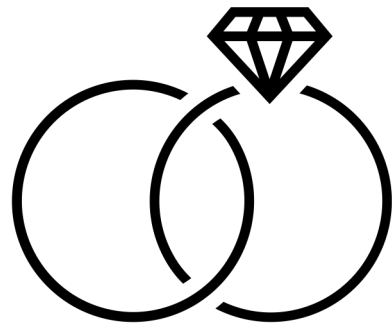
My grandma moved from Mexico to Minnesota when she was 18 (eighteen) years old.

Monday, May 1 (first), 1950 (nineteen fifty).

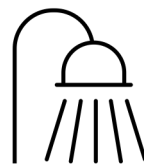
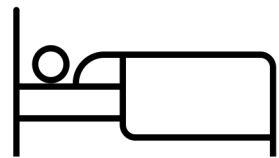


They had many children – including my mom.

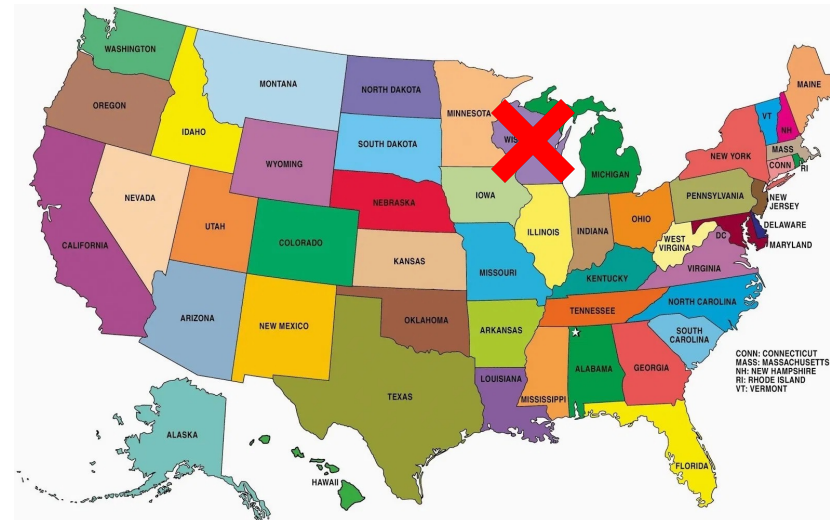

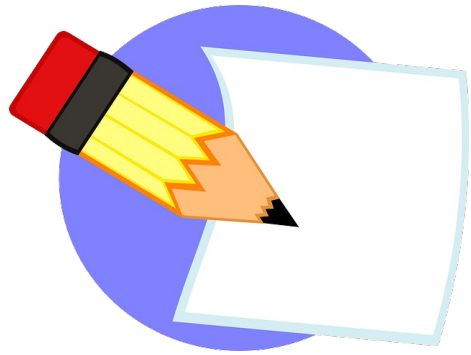
FAMILY GAME

2. Your partner has the information you need at the top of their sheet, and you have the information they need at the bottom of this sheet.

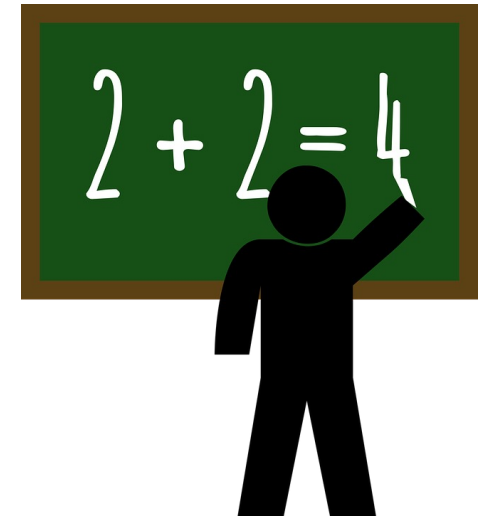
