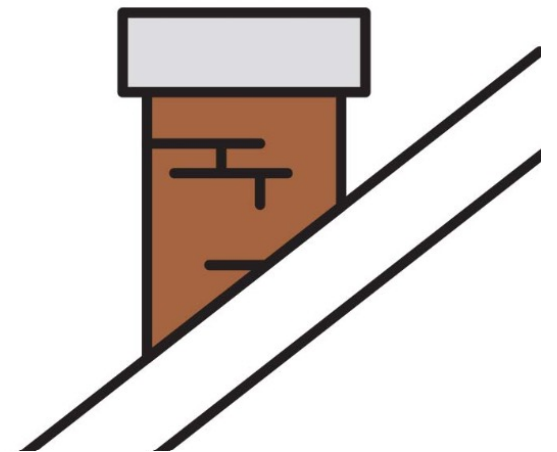
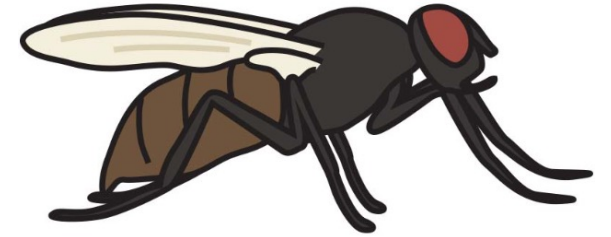
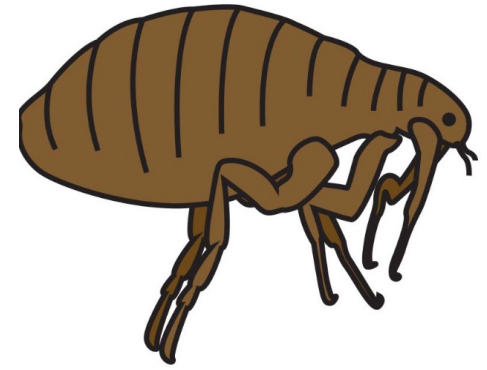
Tongue Twister
